

Past Event Signing ceremony with Medhat El-Sewedy

On September 22nd, the German Arab Chamber of Industry and Commerce (AHK Egypt) held a signing ceremony to celebrate the signing of a certification agreement for the Medhat Elsewedy school of Applied Technology (MEAT) in the printing specialization.

The ceremony was honored by the esteemed presence of. Dr. Ayman Bahaa Eldin, Vice Minister of Education for Technical Education; General Dr. Amr Bossila, Director of the General Directorate of Dual Education, Training and Applied Technology at the Ministry of Education and Technical Education; Eng. Medhat Hafez Elsewedy, Founder and CEO of Medhat El-Sewedy Print House; Dr. Karim Elsewedy, Executive Manager of Medhat Elsewedy Print House; and Ms. Maren Diale-Schellschmidt, AHK Egypt CEO.

This collaboration agreement aims certify apprentices at Medhat El-Sewedy Applied Technology School in the field of advanced printing technology across many printing departments, including "digital and offset" printing. Ms. Diale underlined the significance of this kind of collaboration, emphasizing its goal to equip apprentices—accredited in accordance with German standards and the most recent technological advancements in this field—for both the domestic and global marketplaces. She also emphasized the German Federal Republic's recognition and oversight of Egypt's advancements in technical education and vocational training.







Past Event Midterm and final exams

Midterm and final exams have been conducted across various sectors, marking a significant milestone in vocational education. These assessments ensure that both theoretical knowledge and practical skills align with industry standards, preparing apprentices for real-world challenges.

From August 5th to 7th, AHK Egypt in cooperation with STA Sadat held exams for 64 apprentices in Electrical Maintenance, along with 48 apprentices in IT on August 6th and 7th.

On August 14th and 15th, 20 apprentices completed their C-Level Midterm exams in Ready Made Garments at STA2. The Busway midterm took place on August 13, 14, and 21, with 32 apprentices participating, while 109 apprentices sat for the Cables midterm on August 19, 22, and 28.

In addition from September 2nd till 5th, logistics exams were conducted across STA 2 and STA Sadat, midterms and finals for 83 apprentices on B-Level and completing their theoretical and practical assessments in addition to midterm for 45 apprentices from STA Zohr. Additionally, 24 apprentices from STA Sadat took their C-Level Midterm exams in Railways Engineering on September 8th and 9th.

These exams reflect the ongoing commitment to developing a highly skilled workforce ready to meet the demands of various industries. By integrating both theoretical and practical components, Our team ensures that apprentices are well-equipped for their future careers. We extend our congratulations to all involved and look forward to their continued success as they progress through the program.


Our guest speaker was Ms. Shorokr Zedan, CEO & Managing Director, Ta'heal for VET Skills Excellence.
